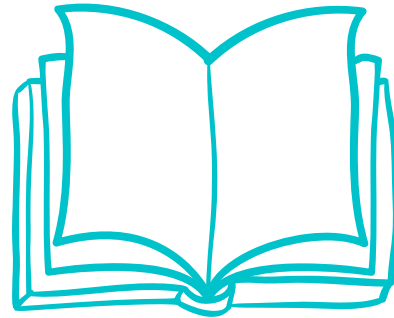

### **HOMEBOUND SERVICES**



## WHAT IS HOMEBOUND SERVICE?

Homebound Service allows us to bring the Library to folks in the community, people that otherwise wouldn't be able to come in and enjoy the services we provide due to age, illness, or other factors.

We also extend our services to caregivers of homebound patrons.

Verification of Homebound status is required by the Homebound Coordinator in order for services to begin.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS SERVICE?

You must be a Boulder City resident who is unable to visit the library. These services are for both short term and long term.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

To fit the needs of our patrons, we offer two options for Homebound Services:

### Option 1 : Pickup

Materials will be held at the Circulation desk for a family member, friend, or caregiver to pick up on your behalf.

### Option 2 : Delivery

Our Coordinator will bring materials to your home or facility.

For either option, items will be selected based on a reader survey or specific items you have requested. All items will have their loan periods extended and patrons will not incur late fees. Patrons are otherwise still responsible for any items they checked out on their card.

We also offer in-home instruction on how to utilize databases, e-books and magazines, audio books, and the Catalog.
